

# Random Object

## OBJECTIVE

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To use words and images to verbally and visually communicate a story.

## IN-CLASS GROUP WORK

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1. **Qualify your object.** Present your two random objects to the group. Discuss. Select one object to use for your project.
2. **Develop a story about the object.** Brainstorm and create a story about your object. Name it. Be inventive and creative.
3. **Select images to support the “mood” and “style” of your story.** Shoot or compose images or find stock imagery that visually communicates your story.
4. **Choose colors that communicate the “attributes” of your story.** Select a primary and secondary palette of colors that communicates your story.

## HOMEWORK

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1. **Write your story.** Write a story about your selected object that is concise and well developed. Make sure your story is grammatically correct, well written, and with no spelling errors.
  - **Word count:** 500–700
  - **Program:** Google doc
  - **Naming:** LastNameFirstInitial\_Random (e.g.; AndersonD\_Random)

2. **Create a mood board.** Compose images and colors on one running page. Quality of content and aesthetics of the page layout are important. Be mindful of the page grid and margins.
  - **Page size:** To be determined (you select)
  - **File size:** 10MB or less
  - **Program:** Adobe InDesign or Illustrator; save as a PDF
  - **Naming:** LastNameFirstInitial\_[ProjectName].pdf (e.g.; AndersonD\_Ebot.pdf)
